- 1 On page 1, after line 15, insert the following:
- "NEW SECTION. Sec. 2. A new section is added to chapter 47.60 2 RCW to read as follows: 3
- 4 (1) The driver of a vehicle waiting in a holding area operated by Washington state ferries shall not have the vehicle idle in excess of three consecutive minutes if the vehicle is gasoline-powered or in 7 excess of five consecutive minutes if the vehicle is diesel-powered, unless:
- 9 (a) The vehicle is being used as an emergency vehicle in an 10 emergency situation;
- (b) The vehicle is required by a federal, state, or local law or 11 official, but only to the extent necessary to comply with such a 12 13 requirement;
- 14 The vehicle's engine is providing auxiliary power 15 activities other than heating or air conditioning, such as loading, refrigeration, well drilling, or farming; 16
- 17 (d) Running the vehicle's engine is necessary for maintenance, servicing, repair, or diagnostic purposes; 18
- 19 (e) Running the vehicle's engine during adverse weather conditions 20 is necessary to ensure the safe operation of the vehicle; or
- (f) The ambient air temperature is below twenty degrees Fahrenheit 21 for gasoline-powered vehicles or below thirty-two degrees Fahrenheit 22 for diesel-powered vehicles, and idling of the vehicle is necessary to 23 24 ensure the safety or health of the passengers or driver.
 - (2) RCW 47.04.090 does not apply to this section."
