AN ACT Relating to the public disclosure of sensitive fish and wildlife data; amending RCW 42.56.430; and adding a new section to chapter 77.12 RCW.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:

5 **Sec. 1.** RCW 42.56.430 and 2005 c 274 s 423 are each amended to 6 read as follows:

7 The following information relating to fish and wildlife is exempt 8 from disclosure under this chapter:

9 (1) Commercial fishing catch data from logbooks required to be 10 provided to the department of fish and wildlife under RCW 77.12.047, 11 when the data identifies specific catch location, timing, or 12 methodology and the release of which would result in unfair competitive 13 disadvantage to the commercial fisher providing the catch data, 14 however, this information may be released to government agencies 15 concerned with the management of fish and wildlife resources;

(2) Sensitive <u>fish and</u> wildlife data ((obtained)). Sensitive fish
and wildlife data may be released to the following entities and their
agents for fish, wildlife, land management purposes, or scientific
research needs: Government agencies, public utilities, and accredited

colleges and universities. Sensitive fish and wildlife data may be 1 released to tribal governments. Sensitive fish and wildlife data may 2 also be released to the owner, lessee, or right-of-way or easement 3 holder of the private land to which the data pertains. The release of 4 sensitive fish and wildlife data may be subject to a confidentiality 5 agreement, except upon release of sensitive fish and wildlife data to б the owner, lessee, or right-of-way or easement holder of private land 7 who initially provided the data. Sensitive fish and wildlife data does 8 not include data related to reports of predatory wildlife as specified 9 in section 2 of this act. Sensitive fish and wildlife data must meet 10 at least one of the following criteria of this subsection as applied by 11 12 the department of fish and wildlife((, however, sensitive wildlife data 13 may be released to government agencies concerned with the management of 14 fish and wildlife resources. As used in this subsection, sensitive 15 wildlife data includes)):

16 (a) The nesting sites or specific locations of endangered species 17 designated under RCW 77.12.020, or threatened or sensitive species 18 classified by rule of the department of fish and wildlife;

(b) Radio frequencies used in, or locational data generated by,telemetry studies; or

(c) Other location data that could compromise the viability of a specific fish or wildlife population, and where at least one of the following criteria are met:

24 (i) The species has a known commercial or black market value;

25 (ii) There is a history of malicious take of that species <u>and the</u> 26 <u>species behavior or ecology renders it especially vulnerable</u>; ((or))

(iii) There is a known demand to visit, take, or disturb((, and the species behavior or ecology renders it especially vulnerable)) the species; or

30 <u>(iv)</u> The species has an extremely limited distribution and 31 concentration; and

32 (3) The personally identifying information of persons who acquire 33 recreational licenses under RCW 77.32.010 or commercial licenses under 34 chapter 77.65 or 77.70 RCW, except name, address of contact used by the 35 department, and type of license, endorsement, or tag; however, the 36 department of fish and wildlife may disclose personally identifying 37 information to:

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(a) Government agencies concerned with the management of fish and
wildlife resources;

3 (b) The department of social and health services, child support 4 division, and to the department of licensing in order to implement RCW 5 77.32.014 and 46.20.291; and

6 (c) Law enforcement agencies for the purpose of firearm possession 7 enforcement under RCW 9.41.040.

8 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> Sec. 2. A new section is added to chapter 77.12 RCW 9 to read as follows:

The department shall post on its internet web site all reported 10 11 predatory wildlife interactions, including reported human safety 12 confrontations or sightings as well as the known details of reported depredations by predatory wildlife on humans, pets, or livestock, 13 within ten days of receiving the report. The posted material must 14 include, but is not limited to, the location and time, the known 15 16 details, and a running summary of such reported interactions by 17 identified specie and interaction type within each affected county. For the purposes of this section and RCW 42.56.430, "predatory 18 wildlife" means grizzly bears, wolves, and cougars. 19

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
