- 7 (5) The institutions of higher education will participate in outreach activities to increase the number of veterans who receive 8 tuition waivers. Colleges and universities shall 9 revise the 10 application for admissions so that all applicants shall have the opportunity to advise the institution that they are veterans who need 11 assistance. If a person indicates on the application for admissions 12 13 that the person is a veteran who is in need of assistance, then the institution of higher education shall ask the person whether they have 14 any funds disbursed in accordance with the Montgomery GI Bill available 15 16 to them. Each institution shall encourage veterans to utilize funds 17 available to them in accordance with the Montgomery GI Bill prior to 18 providing the veteran a tuition waiver.
- NEW SECTION. Sec. 2. If specific funding for the purposes of this act, referencing this act by bill or chapter number, is not provided by June 30, 2007, in the omnibus appropriations act, this act is null and void.
