WHEREAS, The Food and Drug Administration issues regulatory letters to companies that violate Food and Drug Administration guidelines; and WHEREAS, The Food and Drug Administration issues regulatory letters for only a small percentage of the advertisements it reviews; and

companies from making misleading claims in advertisements for prescription pharmaceuticals; and
