SB 6609-S - DIGEST

(AS OF SENATE 2ND READING 2/16/2008)

Limits the charge under the building code for permits for specialty agricultural buildings constructed on a commercial agricultural operation to seventy-five dollars or less.

Defines specialty agricultural structures as those that are designed and constructed to house farm equipment, hay, grain, poultry, livestock, or other horticultural products. Human habitation, employment public use, and where agricultural products are processed, treated, or packaged are not permitted uses of a specialty agricultural building. For the purposes of this act, "commercial agricultural operation" means an operation that generates an average of at least ten thousand dollars gross income per year from the sale of agricultural products.
