- 6 (1) There shall be a fund known as the federal forest revolving 7 account. The state treasurer, who shall be custodian of the revolving
- 8 account, shall deposit into the revolving account the funds for each
- 9 county received by the state in accordance with Title 16, section 500,
- 10 United States Code. The state treasurer shall distribute these moneys
- 11 to the counties according to the determined proportional area. The
- 12 county legislative authority shall expend fifty percent of the money
- 13 for the benefit of the public roads and other public purposes as
- 14 authorized by federal statute or public schools of such county and not
- 15 otherwise. Disbursements by the counties of the remaining fifty
- 16 percent of the money shall be as authorized by the superintendent of
- 17 public instruction, or the superintendent's designee, and shall occur
- 18 in the manner provided in subsection (2) of this section.
- 19 (2) No later than thirty days following receipt of the funds from
- 20 the federal government, the superintendent of public instruction shall
- 21 apportion moneys distributed to counties for schools to public school
- 22 districts in the respective counties in proportion to the number of
- 23 full time equivalent students enrolled in each public school district
- 24 to the number of full time equivalent students enrolled in public
- 25 schools in the county. In apportioning these funds, the
- 26 superintendent of public instruction shall utilize the October
- 27 enrollment count.

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 $\overline{\text{EFFECT:}}$ Eliminates the deduction of federal forest revenues from state school-apportionment payments, allowing districts to receive full state school-apportionment payments in addition to federal forest revenues.

Fiscal impact: Approximately \$18 million per year, general-fund state.

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
