1 On page 5, after line 29, strike all material through line 35 and 2 insert the following: 3 4 "(e) The sum of thirty-six million dollars for the fiscal year 2011 5 may be expended in lieu of state general fund payments to hospitals. 6 The sum of thirty-six million five-hundred thousand dollars for fiscal 7 year 2011 shall be expended to increase subsidized basic health plan 8 enrollment by approximately 9,830 individuals. An additional sum of 9 thirteen million five-hundred thousand dollars for fiscal year 2011 10 may be expended to increase enrollment in the basic health plan by 11 approximately an additional 5,770 individuals if additional federal 12 financial participation under section 5001 of P.L. No. 111-5 is 13 extended beyond December 31, 2010. The sum of eighty-three million 14 five-hundred thousand dollars for the 2011-13 fiscal biennium may be 15 expended to increase subsidized basic health plan enrollment by 16 approximately 15,650 individuals above the levels funded in the 2009operating appropriations act. If federal 17 11 biennial 18 participation becomes available to support the basic health program, 19 enrollment and/or funding levels may be adjusted accordingly to 20 support continued enrollment pursuant to the 2011-13 biennial 21 operating appropriations act." 22
