3 "Sec. 1. RCW 43.215.090 and 2007 c 394 s 3 are each amended to 4 read as follows:

(1) The early learning advisory council is established to advise 5 6 the department on statewide early learning ((community needs and progress)) issues that would build a comprehensive system of quality 7 early learning programs and services for Washington's children and 8 9 families by assessing needs and the availability of services, aligning 10 resources, developing plans for data collection and professional development of early childhood educators, and establishing key 11 12 performance measures.

(2) The council shall work in conjunction with the department to develop a statewide early learning plan that ((crosses systems and sectors to promote)) guides the department in promoting alignment of private and public sector actions, objectives, and resources, and ((to ensure)) ensuring school readiness.

18 (3) The council shall include diverse, statewide representation 19 from public, nonprofit, and for-profit entities. Its membership shall 20 reflect regional, racial, and cultural diversity to adequately 21 represent the needs of all children and families in the state.

(4) Councilmembers shall serve two-year terms. However, to stagger the terms of the council, the initial appointments for twelve of the members shall be for one year. Once the initial one-year to two-year terms expire, all subsequent terms shall be for two years, with the terms expiring on June 30th of the applicable year. The terms shall be staggered in such a way that, where possible, the terms of members representing a specific group do not expire simultaneously.

29 (5) The council shall consist of not more than ((twenty-five)) 30 twenty-three members, as follows: 1 (a) The governor shall appoint at least one representative from 2 each of the following: The department, the office of financial 3 management, the department of social and health services, the 4 department of health, the higher education coordinating board, and the 5 state board for community and technical colleges;

6 (b) One representative from the office of the superintendent of 7 public instruction, to be appointed by the superintendent of public 8 instruction;

9 (c) The governor shall appoint ((at least)) seven leaders in early 10 childhood education, with at least one representative with experience 11 or expertise in each of the <u>areas such as the</u> following ((areas)): 12 Children with disabilities, the K-12 system, family day care providers, 13 and child care centers;

14 (d) Two members of the house of representatives, one from each 15 caucus, and two members of the senate, one from each caucus, to be 16 appointed by the speaker of the house of representatives and the 17 president of the senate, respectively;

(e) Two parents, one of whom serves on the department's parentadvisory council, to be appointed by the governor;

20 (f) ((Two)) <u>One</u> representative((s)) of the private-public 21 partnership created in RCW 43.215.070, to be appointed by the 22 partnership board;

(g) One representative designated by sovereign tribal governments;and

25 (h) One representative from the Washington federation of 26 independent schools.

(6) The council shall be cochaired by one representative of a state agency and one nongovernmental member, to be elected by the council for two-year terms.

30 (7) Each member of the board shall be compensated in accordance 31 with RCW 43.03.240 and reimbursed for travel expenses incurred in 32 carrying out the duties of the board in accordance with RCW 43.03.050 33 and 43.03.060.

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(8) The department shall provide staff support to the council."
