3 On page 2, line 35 of the amendment, after "1999" insert "; or  
4 (d) Electric generating capacity from a hydroelectric generation  
5 project set aside specifically to facilitate eligible renewable  
6 resource integration when: (i) The integration provider can provide  
7 in-hour generation following and regulating reserve services where such  
8 services are identified in a contract or where such services are self-  
9 provided to integrate eligible renewable resource generation within the  
10 Pacific Northwest; (ii) the integration provider can demonstrate all  
11 integration services are provided by hydroelectric generating projects;  
12 (iii) the hydroelectric generating capacity made available for  
13 integration is limited to the firming requirements of the eligible  
14 renewable resource receiving services; and (iv) the generating capacity  
15 comes from a nonfederal facility"

EFFECT: Hydroelectric generation used to shape and integrate an eligible renewable resource, such as wind, is an eligible renewable resource.

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
