3 "Sec. 1. 2008 c 329 s 516 (uncodified) is amended to read as 4 follows:

5 FOR THE SUPERINTENDENT OF PUBLIC INSTRUCTION. (1) Appropriations made 6 in this act to the office of superintendent of public instruction 7 shall initially be allotted as required by this act. Subsequent 8 allotment modifications shall not include transfers of moneys between 9 sections of this act, except as expressly provided in subsection (2) 10 of this section.

(2) The appropriations to the office of the superintendent of 11 12 public instruction in this act shall be expended for the programs and 13 amounts specified in this act. However, after May 1, ((2008)) 2009, 14 unless specifically prohibited by this act and after approval by the 15 director of financial management, the superintendent of public 16 instruction may transfer state general fund and student achievement 17 fund appropriations for fiscal year ((2008)) 2009 among the following 18 programs to meet the apportionment schedule for a specified formula in 19 another of these programs: General apportionment; employee 20 compensation adjustments; pupil transportation; special education 21 programs; institutional education programs; transitional bilingual 22 programs; student achievement; and learning assistance programs.

(3) The director of financial management shall notify the appropriate legislative fiscal committees in writing prior to approving any allotment modifications or transfers under this section.

1 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> Sec. 2. This act is necessary for the immediate 2 preservation of the public peace, health, or safety, or support of the 3 state government and its existing public institutions, and takes 4 effect immediately."

6 On page 1, line 1 of the title, after "schools" insert "fund 7 transfers during fiscal year 2009; amending 2008 c 329 s 516 8 (uncodified); and declaring an emergency"

EFFECT: The list of OSPI appropriations that may be transferred to cover under or over expenditures in other programs is expanded to include the I-728 Student Achievement Fund allocations.
