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1 On page 81, after line 25, insert "(2) Any cash balance in the  
2 waste tire removal account shall be transferred to the motor vehicle  
3 account for the purpose of road wear related maintenance on state and  
4 local public highways."

5 On page 86, after line 37, insert the following:

6 **"Sec. 705.** RCW 70.95.532 and 2009 c 261 s 4 are each amended to  
7 read as follows:

8 (1) All receipts from tire fees imposed under RCW 70.95.510,  
9 except as provided in subsection (2) of this section, must be  
10 deposited in the waste tire removal account created under RCW  
11 70.95.521. Moneys in the account may be spent only after  
12 appropriation. Expenditures from the account may be used for the  
13 cleanup of unauthorized waste tire piles and measures that prevent  
14 future accumulation of unauthorized waste tire piles.

15 (2) On September 1st of odd-numbered years, the state treasurer  
16 must transfer any cash balance in excess of one million dollars from  
17 the waste tire removal account created under RCW 70.95.521 to the  
18 motor vehicle account for the purpose of road wear related maintenance  
19 on state and local public highways.

20 (3) During the 2009-11 fiscal biennium, the legislature may  
21 transfer any cash balance in excess of one million dollars from the  
22 waste tire removal account created under RCW 70.95.521 to the motor  
23 vehicle account for the purpose of road wear related maintenance on  
24 state and local public highways."

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26  
27 Renumber the sections and subsections consecutively and correct  
28 any internal references accordingly.

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30  
31 EFFECT: The appropriation for the Washington State  
32 Ferries reservation system is moved into the subsection  
33 that has the appropriations for other system-wide  
34 projects.

1 The due date is adjusted for the Washington State Ferries'  
2 updated vessel life-cycle cost model report.

3 Corrections are made to transfers and certain bond proceeds  
4 appropriations to conform with the underlying intent of the  
5 budget.

6 During the 2009-11 biennium, the legislature may transfer  
7 any cash balance in excess of one million dollars from the  
8 Waste Tire Removal Account to the Motor Vehicle Account for  
9 the purpose of road wear related maintenance on the state  
and local highways.

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
