1 AN ACT Relating to campaign contribution limitations prior to and 2 during legislative sessions; and reenacting and amending RCW 42.17.710.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:

4 Sec. 1. RCW 42.17.710 and 2006 c 348 s 5 and 2006 c 344 s 31 are 5 each reenacted and amended to read as follows:

(1) During the period beginning on ((the thirtieth day before)) the б 7 date a regular legislative session convenes and continuing through the date of final adjournment, and during the period beginning on the date 8 9 a special legislative session convenes and continuing through the date 10 that session adjourns, no state official or a person employed by or 11 acting on behalf of a state official or state legislator may solicit or 12 accept contributions to a public office fund, to a candidate or 13 authorized committee, or to retire a campaign debt. Contributions 14 received through the mail on or after ((the thirtieth day before)) the 15 date a regular legislative session <u>convenes</u> may be accepted if the 16 contribution is postmarked prior to ((the thirtieth day before)) the 17 date the session convenes.
