1 AN ACT Relating to delaying the implementation of the family leave 2 insurance program; and amending RCW 49.86.030 and 49.86.210.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:

4 **Sec. 1.** RCW 49.86.030 and 2007 c 357 s 5 are each amended to read 5 as follows:

Beginning October 1, ((2009)) 2012, family leave insurance benefits are payable to an individual during a period in which the individual is unable to perform his or her regular or customary work because he or she is on family leave if the individual:

(1) Files a claim for benefits in each week in which the individualis on family leave, and as required by rules adopted by the director;

12 (2) Has been employed for at least six hundred eighty hours in13 employment during the individual's qualifying year;

(3) Establishes an application year. An application year may not
be established if the qualifying year includes hours worked before
establishment of a previous application year;

17 (4) Consents to the disclosure of information or records deemed 18 private and confidential under chapter 50.13 RCW. Initial disclosure 19 of this information and these records by the employment security 1 department to the department is solely for purposes related to the 2 administration of this chapter. Further disclosure of this information 3 or these records is subject to RCW 49.86.020(3);

4 (5) Discloses whether or not he or she owes child support 5 obligations as defined in RCW 50.40.050; and

6 (6) Documents that he or she has provided the employer from whom 7 family leave is to be taken with written notice of the individual's 8 intention to take family leave in the same manner as an employee is 9 required to provide notice in RCW 49.78.250.

10 **Sec. 2.** RCW 49.86.210 and 2007 c 357 s 26 are each amended to read 11 as follows:

Beginning September 1, ((<del>2010</del>)) <u>2013</u>, the department shall report to the legislature by September 1st of each year on projected and actual program participation, premium rates, fund balances, and outreach efforts.

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
