1            AN ACT Relating to residential habilitation centers; and amending  
2 RCW 71A.20.020.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:

4            **Sec. 1.** RCW 71A.20.020 and 1994 c 215 s 1 are each amended to read  
5 as follows:

6            (~~The following residential habilitation centers are permanently~~  
7 ~~established to provide services to persons with developmental~~  
8 ~~disabilities: Lakeland Village, located at Medical Lake, Spokane~~  
9 ~~county; Rainier School, located at Buckley, Pierce county; Yakima~~  
10 ~~Valley School, located at Selah, Yakima county; Fircrest School,~~  
11 ~~located at Seattle, King county; and Frances Haddon Morgan Children's~~  
12 ~~Center, located at Bremerton, Kitsap county.)) The department is  
13 authorized to provide residential and habilitation services through  
14 state residential habilitation centers to persons with developmental  
15 disabilities who are found eligible and in need of the level of care  
16 provided by a nursing facility or intermediate care facility for the  
17 mentally retarded, as those terms are described by federal law.~~
