1 On page 74, after line 5, insert the following:

2 "Sec. 701. RCW 1.08.015 and 2009 c 186 s 1 are each amended to 3 read as follows:

4 Subject to such general policies as may be promulgated by the 5 committee and to the general supervision of the committee, the reviser 6 shall:

7 (1) Codify for consolidation into the Revised Code of Washington 8 all laws of a general and permanent nature heretofore or hereafter 9 enacted by the legislature, and assign permanent numbers as provided 10 by law to all new titles, chapters, and sections so added to the 11 revised code.

12 (2) Edit and revise such laws for such consolidation, to the 13 extent deemed necessary or desirable by the reviser and without 14 changing the meaning of any such law, in the following respects only:

15 (a) Make capitalization uniform with that followed generally in 16 the revised code.

(b) Make chapter or section division and subdivision designations uniform with ((that)) those followed in the revised code, except that for chapter 62A.9A RCW, the reviser shall make section division and subdivision designations uniform with those followed by the national conference of commissioners on uniform state laws for article 9 of the uniform commercial code.

(c) Substitute for the term "this act," where necessary, the term reserve a section," "part," "code," "chapter," or "title," or reference to specific section or chapter numbers, as the case may require.

26 (d) Substitute for reference to a section of an "act," the proper 27 code section number reference.

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1 (e) Substitute for "as provided in the preceding section" and 2 other phrases of similar import, the proper code section number 3 references.

4 (f) Substitute the proper calendar date for "effective date of 5 this act," "date of passage of this act," and other phrases of similar 6 import.

7 (g) Strike out figures where merely a repetition of written words,
8 and substitute, where deemed advisable for uniformity, written words
9 for figures.

10 (h) Rearrange any misplaced statutory material, incorporate any 11 omitted statutory material as well as correct manifest errors in 12 spelling, and manifest clerical or typographical errors, or errors by 13 way of additions or omissions.

14 (i) Correct manifest errors in references, by chapter or section15 number, to other laws.

16 (j) Correct manifest errors or omissions in numbering or 17 renumbering sections of the revised code.

18 (k) Rearrange the order of sections to conform to such logical 19 arrangement of subject matter as may most generally be followed in the 20 revised code, and alphabetize definition sections, when to do so will 21 not change the meaning or effect of such sections.

(1) Change the wording of section captions, if any, and providecaptions to new chapters and sections.

24 (m) Strike provisions manifestly obsolete.

(3) Create new code titles, chapters, and sections of the Revised Code of Washington, or otherwise revise the title, chapter and rectional organization of the code, all as may be required from time to time, to effectuate the orderly and logical arrangement of the statutes. Such new titles, chapters, and sections, and organizational revisions, shall have the same force and effect as the ninety-one titles originally enacted and designated as the "Revised Code of Washington" pursuant to the code adoption acts codified in chapter 1.04 RCW."

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1 Renumber the remaining sections consecutively and correct the 2 title.

<u>EFFECT:</u> Directs the Code Reviser to use section and subsection numbering for Washington's Article 9A of the Uniform Commercial Code that is consistent with the numbering used by the National Conference of Commissioners on Uniform State Laws for Article 9 of the Uniform Commercial Code.

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
