- 8 needed to cancel any previous registration. Notification must be made
- 9 to the state elections office of the applicant's previous state of
- 10 registration. If proof of citizenship is not provided, the transfer
- 11 may not be made.
- 12 (2) A county auditor receiving official information that a voter
- 13 has registered to vote in another state shall immediately cancel that
- 14 voter's registration on the official state voter registration list."

- 20 "Sec. 16. RCW 29A.08.410 and 2009 c 369 s 22 are each amended
- 21 to read as follows:
- 22 (1) A registered voter who changes his or her residence from one
- 23 address to another within the same county may transfer his or her
- 24 registration to the new address in one of the following ways:
- 25 (((1))) (a) Sending the county auditor a request stating both the
- 26 voter's present address and the address from which the voter was last
- 27 registered;

- 1  $((\frac{(2)}{(2)}))$  <u>(b)</u> Appearing in person before the county auditor and
- 2 making such a request; or
- 3 ((<del>(3) Telephoning or e-mailing the county auditor to transfer the</del>
- 4 registration; or
- 5 (4)) (c) Submitting a voter registration application.
- 6 (2) When transferring a registration to a new address, the voter
- 7 must provide the county auditor with documented proof that he or she
- 8 is a United States citizen. If documentation of citizenship is not
- 9 provided, the voter's registration may not be transferred.

- 11 Sec. 17. RCW 29A.08.420 and 2009 c 369 s 23 are each amended to
- 12 read as follows:
- 13 A registered voter who changes his or her residence from one
- 14 county to another county must do so by submitting a voter registration
- 15 form((-)), and submitting documented proof of citizenship. If proof of
- 16 citizenship is not provided, the voter's registration may not be
- 17 transferred. If documentation is provided, the county auditor of the
- 18 voter's new county shall transfer the voter's registration from the
- 19 county of the previous registration."

- On page 29, line 3, after "(1)" insert "The county auditor must
- 25 not mail ballots to first time voters. First time voters must provide
- 26 the county auditor with documented proof of citizenship before they
- 27 are issued a ballot. Documented proof of citizenship includes:
- 28 (a) A driver's license number or government issued identification
- 29 if citizenship is indicated;
- 30 (b) A photocopy of a birth certificate;
- 31 (c) A passport; or
- 32 (d) Naturalization documents or a certificate of naturalization.
- 33 (2) Service and overseas voters are exempt from section 1 of this
- 34 section.
