1 On page 5, line 4 of the amendment, after "(7)" insert "On the
2 effective date of this section, and prior to January 1, 2015, the local
3 air pollution control authority or the department shall, within
4 available resources, provide assistance to households using solid fuel
5 burning devices to reduce the emissions from those devices or change
6 out to a lower emission device. Prior to the effective date of a
7 prohibition, as defined in this section, on the use of uncertified
8 stoves, the department or local air pollution control authority shall
9 provide public education in the nonattainment area regarding how
10 households can reduce their emissions through cleaner burning
11 practices, the importance of respecting burn bans, and the
12 opportunities for assistance in obtaining a cleaner device. If the
13 area is designated as a nonattainment area as of January 1, 2015, or if
14 required by the United States environmental protection agency, the
15 local air pollution control authority or the department may prohibit
16 the use of uncertified devices.

18 On page 5, beginning on line 7 of the amendment, after "(b)" strike
19 all material through "department." on line 10 and insert "Prohibit the
20 use" or "prohibition" may include requiring disclosure of an
21 uncertified device, removal, or rendering inoperable, as may be
22 approved by rule by a local air pollution control authority or the
23 department. The effective date of such a rule may not be prior to
24 January 1, 2015."

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
