1 On page 10, line 13, after "cannabis;" insert the following:

2 "(v) Have a business or practice which consists primarily of
3 examining patients for the purpose of authorizing the medical use of
4 cannabis;

5 (vi) Include any statement or reference, visual or otherwise, on
6 the medical use of cannabis in any advertisement for his or her
7 business or practice;"

8
9 Reletter the remaining subsection consecutively and correct any
10 internal references accordingly.

11 On page 10, after line 16, insert the following:

12 "(3) A violation of any provision of subsection (2) of this
13 section constitutes unprofessional conduct under chapter 18.130 RCW."

EFFECT: Health care professionals may not have a practice with
the primary purpose of authorizing the medical use of cannabis.
They also may not include any statement or reference on the
medical use of cannabis in any advertisement for their business
or practice. Violation of these provisions constitutes
unprofessional conduct.
