1 On page 3, beginning on line 14, strike all of subsection (3)(g)

2 Reletter the remaining subsection consecutively and correct any
3 internal references accordingly.

4 On page 3, line 24, after "subsection." insert "The signage must
5 contain the following provision in bold-faced type: "WARNING: Cigar
6 smoking causes lung cancer, heart disease, and other diseases and
7 cancers. Cigars contain nicotine, tar, and carcinogens. Cigar smoking
8 is not a safe alternative to cigarette smoking.""

9 On page 5, beginning on line 4, strike all of subsection (4)(g)

10 Reletter the remaining subsection consecutively and correct any
11 internal references accordingly.

12 On page 5, line 14, after "subsection." insert "The signage must
13 contain the following provision in bold-faced type: "WARNING: Cigar
14 smoking causes lung cancer, heart disease, and other diseases and
15 cancers. Cigars contain nicotine, tar, and carcinogens. Cigar smoking
16 is not a safe alternative to cigarette smoking.""

17 On page 5, beginning on line 15, strike all of subsection (5)

18 Renumber the remaining subsections consecutively and correct any
19 internal references accordingly.

EFFECT: Removes the requirement that establishments must have a

signed acknowledgment of risk associated with working in an environment where tobacco smoke may be present from each employee. Requires specific language to be displayed in a conspicuous location warning of the hazards of tobacco smoke.
