1 AN ACT Relating to wireless communications structures; amending RCW 2 43.21C.0384; and creating a new section.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:

4 Sec. 1. RCW 43.21C.0384 and 1996 c 323 s 2 are each amended to 5 read as follows:

6 (1) Decisions pertaining to applications to site ((personal))
7 wireless service facilities are not subject to the requirements of RCW
8 43.21C.030(2)(c), if those facilities meet the following requirements:

9 $(a)((\frac{i}{i}))$ The $((\frac{facility}{i}) to be sited is a microcell and is to be$ 10 attached to an existing structure that is not a residence or school and does not contain a residence or a school)) collocation of new 11 12 equipment, removal of equipment, or replacement of existing equipment 13 on existing or replacement structures does not substantially change the 14 physical dimensions of such structures; or (((ii) the facility includes 15 personal wireless service antennas, other than a microcell, and is to 16 be attached to an existing structure (that may be an existing tower) that is not a residence or school and does not contain a residence or 17 18 a school, and the existing structure to which it is to be attached is

1 located in a commercial, industrial, manufacturing, forest, or 2 agricultural zone; or (iii)))

3 (b) The siting project involves constructing a ((personal))
4 wireless service tower less than sixty feet in height that is located
5 in a commercial, industrial, manufacturing, forest, or agricultural

7 (b) The project is not in)). This exemption does not apply to
8 projects within a designated ((environmentally sensitive)) critical

10 (c) The project does not consist of a series of actions: (i) Some 11 of which are not categorically exempt; or (ii) that together may have 12 a probable significant adverse environmental impact)).

13 (2) <u>The exemption authorized under subsection (1) of this section</u> 14 <u>may only be applied to a project consisting of a series of actions when</u> 15 <u>all actions in the series are categorically exempt and the actions</u> 16 <u>together do not have a probable significant adverse environmental</u> 17 <u>impact.</u>

18 (3) The department of ecology shall adopt rules to create a 19 categorical exemption for ((microcells and other personal)) wireless 20 service facilities that meet the conditions set forth in subsections 21 (1) and (2) of this section.

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(((3) For the purposes of this section:))

23 (4) By January 1, 2020, all wireless service providers granted an 24 exemption to RCW 43.21C.030(2)(c) must provide the legislature with the 25 number of permits issued pertaining to wireless service facilities, the 26 number of exemptions granted under this section, and the total dollar 27 investment in wireless service facilities between July 1, 2013, and 28 June 30, 2019.

29 (5) The definitions in this subsection apply throughout this 30 section unless the context clearly requires otherwise.

31 (a) "((Personal)) Wireless services" means wireless data and 32 telecommunications services, including commercial mobile services, 33 commercial mobile data services, unlicensed wireless services, and 34 common carrier wireless exchange access services, as defined by federal 35 laws and regulations.

36 (b) "((Personal)) Wireless service facilities" means facilities for 37 the provision of ((personal)) wireless services.

(("Microcell" means a wireless communication facility 1 (C) consisting of an antenna that is either: (i) Four feet in height and 2 with an area of not more than five hundred eighty square inches; or 3 (ii) if a tubular antenna, no more than four inches in diameter and no 4 more than six feet in length)) <u>"Collocation" means the mounting or</u> 5 б installation of equipment on an existing tower, building, or structure for the purpose of either transmitting or receiving, or both, radio 7 frequency signals for communications purposes. 8

9 <u>(d) "Existing structure" means any existing tower, pole, building,</u> 10 <u>or other structure capable of supporting wireless service facilities.</u>

11 (e) "Substantially change the physical dimensions" means:

12 (i) The mounting of equipment on a structure that would increase 13 the height of the structure by more than ten percent, or twenty feet, 14 whichever is greater; or

15 (ii) The mounting of equipment that would involve adding an 16 appurtenance to the body of the structure that would protrude from the 17 edge of the structure more than twenty feet, or more than the width of 18 the structure at the level of the appurtenance, whichever is greater.

19 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 2.** The code reviser is directed to put the 20 defined terms in RCW 43.21C.0384(5) into alphabetical order.

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
