- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- 4 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 1.** A new section is added to chapter 15.65 RCW to read as follows:
 - (1) A commodity board may appoint up to two nonvoting advisory members to the board who have expertise in marketing, operations, or other topics relevant to the work of the board. The term of office for each nonvoting advisory member must be established in each board's marketing order or agreement, but may not exceed three years. Nonvoting advisory members may serve additional consecutive terms of
- office if reappointed by the board.
- 13 (2) Nonvoting advisory members do not count toward establishing a 14 quorum of the board.
- 15 (3) Nonvoting advisory members must be compensated in the same 16 manner as board members under RCW 15.65.270(4).
