1 AN ACT Relating to assault of a corrections officer, law
2 enforcement officer, community corrections officer, or an employee
3 responsible for the supervision of a sentenced offender in a detention
4 facility; amending RCW 9A.36.011; and prescribing penalties.

5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:

6 **Sec. 1.** RCW 9A.36.011 and 1997 c 196 s 1 are each amended to read
7 as follows:

8 (1) A person is guilty of assault in the first degree if he or
9 she(~~(r)~~):

10 (a) With intent to inflict great bodily harm:

11 (~~(a)~~) (i) Assaults another with a firearm or any deadly weapon or
12 by any force or means likely to produce great bodily harm or death; or

13 (~~(b)~~) (ii) Administers, exposes, or transmits to or causes to be
14 taken by another, poison, the human immunodeficiency virus as defined
15 in chapter 70.24 RCW, or any other destructive or noxious substance; or

16 (~~(c)~~) (iii) Assaults another and inflicts great bodily harm; or

17 (b) Assaults, with a deadly weapon, a corrections officer, law
18 enforcement officer, community corrections officer, or an employee
19 responsible for the supervision of a sentenced offender in a detention

1 facility who was performing his or her official duties at the time of
2 the assault, and the person knew or had reason to know that the victim
3 was a corrections officer, law enforcement officer, community
4 corrections officer, or an employee responsible for the supervision of
5 a sentenced offender in a detention facility.

6 (2) Assault in the first degree is a class A felony.
