## SENATE BILL 5397

State of Washington 63rd Legislature 2013 Regular Session

AN ACT Relating to establishing outcome measures for the community mental health service delivery system; adding a new section to chapter 71.28 RCW; and creating a new section.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:

5 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> Sec. 1. A new section is added to chapter 71.28 RCW 6 to read as follows:

7 (1) The department of social and health services shall establish 8 procedures for measuring client outcomes and delivery system attributes 9 for the community mental health service delivery system. The 10 department must make outcome measures publicly available in a form that 11 allows for comparison of outcomes and levels of improvement between 12 geographic regions of Washington.

13 (2) The following client outcomes must be monitored for the 14 community mental health service delivery system: (a) Improvements in 15 health status; (b) improved participation in employment and education; 16 (c) improved housing stability; (d) improved quality of life, including 17 measures of recovery and resilience; (e) improved access to treatment 18 and health outcomes, as measured by reduction in disparity in 1 population-based studies; (f) reduced criminal justice system
2 involvement; and (g) reduced avoidable utilization of hospital,
3 emergency room, and crisis services.

4 (3) The following delivery system attributes must be monitored for the community mental health service delivery system: (a) Improvements 5 in level of reliance on evidence-based, research-based, and promising б practices; (b) reductions in boarding practices for crisis patients; 7 8 (c) instances of connection and cross-system collaboration with law enforcement and criminal justice agencies; and (d) effectiveness in 9 10 engaging and monitoring health status of forensically involved mental 11 health patients released from incarceration or involuntary commitment 12 within the geographic region.

13 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> Sec. 2. By December 1, 2013, the department of 14 social and health services shall propose an incentive system that would 15 reward superior performance relating to client outcome measures and 16 delivery system attributes described in section 1 of this act, and 17 describe any legal or practical barriers that would need to be 18 addressed prior to implementation of such a system.

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
