1 AN ACT Relating to the prohibition of fees for judicial members of 2 the bar; and amending RCW 2.48.130.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:

4 **Sec. 1.** RCW 2.48.130 and 1957 c 138 s 1 are each amended to read 5 as follows:

The annual membership fees for active members shall be payable on б 7 or before February 1st of each year. The board of governors may establish the amount of such annual membership fee to be effective each 8 9 year: PROVIDED, That written notice of any proposed increase in membership fee shall be sent to active members not less than sixty days 10 prior to the effective date of such increase: PROVIDED FURTHER, That 11 the board of governors may establish the fee at a reduced rate for 12 those who have been active members for less than five years in this 13 14 state or elsewhere. No fee may be assessed against any full-time judicial officer who is not an active member of the bar as defined in 15 16 RCW 2.48.170. A judicial member who applies to return to active status shall not be charged any fee for the period in which he or she was a 17

1 judicial member, nor any investigation fee.
