BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:

- 4 **Sec. 1.** RCW 2.04.070 and 1909 c 24 s 1 are each amended to read as follows:
- 6 When a vacancy on the supreme court occurs by death, resignation,
- 7 or otherwise after the effective date of this section, it may not be
- 8 filled until the number of judges on that court has been reduced to
- 9 <u>seven. Thereafter, the supreme court((, from and after February 26,</u>
- $10 \frac{1909}{1}$) shall consist of ((nine)) seven judges.
- 11 <u>A vacancy can occur by resignation, retirement, death, or</u>
- 12 <u>otherwise</u>.

- 13 Sec. 2. RCW 2.04.071 and 1971 c 81 s 1 are each amended to read as
- 14 follows:
- 15 ((At the next general election, and at each biennial general
- 16 election thereafter, there shall be elected three justices of the
- 17 supreme court, to hold for the full term of six years, and until their
- 18 successors are elected and qualified)) Upon the reduction in size of

- 1 the supreme court from nine to seven justices, no fewer than two and no
- 2 more than three judges may be elected at each biennial general election
- 3 to serve six-year terms, commencing with the second Monday in January

4 succeeding their election.
