 - (1) Employees of companies providing life alert services must provide the location and known medical conditions of their customers when requested by first responders.
- 9 (2) The location and known medical conditions of a customer of a 10 life alert services company may not be shared for commercial purposes 11 without the written consent of the customer.
- 12 (3) For the purposes of this section For the purposes of this 13 section:
- 14 (a) "First responder" means firefighters, law enforcement, and 15 emergency medical personnel as recognized by this state;
- (b) "Life alert services" means a service provided for profit that allows persons in need of emergency assistance to contact a call center through the activation of a wearable device, such as a pendant or bracelet.
