(SUBSTITUTED FOR - SEE 3RD SUB)

Merges medical marijuana and recreational marijuana provisions.

Requires the department of health to convene a work group of representatives of the medical quality assurance commission, the board of osteopathic medicine and surgery, the nursing care quality assurance commission, the board of naturopathy, and certain other persons to develop practice guidelines for health care professionals to consider when authorizing the medical use of marijuana for patients.

Exempts from disclosure under the public records act, records in the medical marijuana registry containing names and other personally identifiable information of qualifying patients and designated providers.

Changes the name of the state liquor control board to the state liquor and cannabis board.

Changes the name of the basic health plan trust account to the basic health services account.

Requires the code reviser to prepare legislation for the 2015 legislative session changing references from the state liquor control board to the state liquor and cannabis board.
