- 1 Strike everything after the enacting clause and insert the 2 following:
- 3 "Sec. 1. RCW 70.14.090 and 2006 c 307 s 2 are each amended to 4 read as follows:
- 5 (1) A health technology clinical committee is established, to 6 include the following eleven members appointed by the administrator 7 in consultation with participating state agencies:
- 8 (a) Six practicing physicians licensed under chapter 18.57 or 9 18.71 RCW; and
- 10 (b) Five other practicing licensed health professionals who use 11 health technology in their scope of practice.
- 12 <u>(i)</u> At least two members of the committee must have professional 13 experience treating women, children, elderly persons, and people with 14 diverse ethnic and racial backgrounds.
- 15 <u>(ii) At least one member of the committee must be appointed from</u>
  16 <u>nominations submitted by a statewide organization representing</u>
  17 nonspecialty allopathic and osteopathic physicians.
- 18 (2) <u>In addition, any rotating clinical expert selected to advise</u>
  19 <u>the committee on a health technology must be a nonvoting member of</u>
  20 the committee.

- (a) Shall not contract with or be employed by a health technology manufacturer or a participating agency during their term or for eighteen months before their appointment. As a condition of appointment, each person shall agree to the terms and conditions imposed by the administrator regarding conflicts of interest;
- (b) Are immune from civil liability for any official acts performed in good faith as members of the committee; and
- (c) Shall be compensated for participation in the work of the committee in accordance with a personal services contract to be executed after appointment and before commencement of activities related to the work of the committee.
- 33  $((\frac{3}{3}))$  (4) Meetings of the committee and any advisory group are 34 subject to chapter 42.30 RCW, the open public meetings act, including

- 1 RCW 42.30.110(1)(1), which authorizes an executive session during a 2 regular or special meeting to consider proprietary or confidential 3 nonpublished information.
  - $((\frac{4}{1}))$  (5) Neither the committee nor any advisory group is an agency for purposes of chapter 34.05 RCW.
  - $((\frac{5}{}))$  <u>(6)</u> The health care authority shall provide administrative support to the committee and any advisory group, and may adopt rules governing their operation."

EFFECT: Requires that at least one member of the Health Technology Clinical Committee (Committee) be appointed from nominations submitted by a statewide organization representing nonspecialty allopathic and osteopathic physicians. Removes the requirement that at least one member of the Committee be a medical expert in the technology under consideration and be appointed by the Washington State Medical Association.

Requires that any rotating clinical expert selected to advise the Committee on a health technology be a nonvoting member of the Committee.
