<u>EFFECT</u>: Provides that a Board of Trustees may provide additional compensation to academic employees that exceeds that provided by the Legislature only after the Legislature fully funds the cost-ofliving increases required by statute and if the Board receives a net increase in state operating funds from the previous fiscal year. Provides that additional compensation must come from: funds generated from tuition paid by new enrollments from the previous fiscal year; funds from any tuition increases authorized by the Legislature; funds from increases in per full time equivalent funding approved by the Legislature; or from any turnover savings.

Provides that, subject to the restrictions, Boards of Trustees may negotiate one-time performance payments based on collectively bargained performance criteria.
