- 16 assessment, shall not be admissible in any court action or other
- 17 judicial or administrative proceeding.
- 18 (c) Nothing in this section shall be construed to limit or
- 19 affect: (i) The right of any employee to pursue any judicial,
- 20 administrative, or other action available with respect to an employer;
- 21 (ii) the right of the department to pursue any judicial,
- 22 administrative, or other action available with respect to an employee
- 23 that is identified as a result of a complaint under this chapter; or
- 24 (iii) the right of the department to pursue any judicial,
- 25 administrative, or other action otherwise authorized."

EFFECT: Provides that an employee who files an administrative complaint preserves the right to a private right of action by providing written notice to the Department of Labor and Industries (Department) within 10 days after receiving the citation and notice of assessment. Provides that if the employee terminates the administrative action, the Department must discontinue its action and vacate a citation and notice of assessment. Provides that the citation and notice of assessment and related information are not admissible in another proceeding. Provides that the provisions do not limit or affect other rights.
