2 material through "grown" on line 9 and insert "and fresh, and if
3 feasible, give preference to Washington grown food"

5 On page 9, beginning on line 13, after "must" strike all material
6 through "in" on line 17 and insert ", by the end of the 2018-19 school
7 year, eliminate the lunch copay for all elementary school and
8 prekindergarten students. The phasing out of the lunch copay for all
9 other students must begin in the 2019-20 school year and be completed
10 by the end of"

EFFECT: (1) Makes the preference for using Washington-grown foods in Breakfast after the Bell programs subject to feasibility considerations.

(2) Removes provisions in the underlying bill requiring the phase out of lunch copays to begin with schools with the highest poverty levels, and adds provisions specifying that: (a) the lunch copay for all elementary and prekindergarten school students must be eliminated by the end of the 2018-19 school year; and (b) the phasing out of the lunch copay for all other students must begin in the 2019-20 school year and be completed by the end of the 2020-21 school year.
