- 2 "NEW SECTION. Sec. 1. (1) The legislature finds that thoughtful
- 3 and evidence-based school food programs are associated with improved
- 4 outcomes for students, including fewer disciplinary incidents, better
- 5 attendance, improved performance on standardized tests, and academic
- 6 success evidenced through increased graduation rates.
- 7 (2) The legislature acknowledges that while many schools currently
- 8 offer breakfast before the school day, and that many students have
- 9 benefited from the elimination of lunch copays for qualifying students
- 10 in kindergarten through third grade, there are significant numbers of
- 11 students who come to school hungry or who lack financial resources to
- 12 pay lunch copays.
- 13 (3) The legislature acknowledges also that existing school-related
- 14 farm programs play an important role in helping students to better
- 15 understanding the relationships between academics, food, farming, and
- 16 good health.
- 17 (4) The legislature finds that the purpose of sections 1 through 11
- 18 of this act is to achieve the public policy benefits specified in
- 19 subsection (1) of this section: improved student outcomes. To do so
- 20 the legislature intends to:
- 21 (a) Expand opportunities for students to have a healthy breakfast
- 22 by requiring schools with large populations of qualifying low-income
- 23 students to offer breakfast after the bell programs, a program model
- 24 that has increased breakfast participation rates in other states;
- 25 (b) Increase support for the elimination of lunch copays for
- 26 qualifying students in prekindergarten and in grades for which the copay
- 27 remains; and

(c) Increase support for school-related farm programs that have 1 2 proven successful in supporting students through policies that, among 3 other benefits, promote student health and readiness through healthy 4 local foods and school garden projects."

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6 Renumber the remaining sections consecutively and correct any 7 internal references accordingly.

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Correct the title.

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Adds intent language, including specifying legislative intent to: (1) require qualifying schools to offer Breakfast after the Bell programs; (2) increase support for the elimination of lunch copays for qualifying students; and (3) increase support schoolrelated farm programs.

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
