EFFECT: Provides that a member of the State Building Code Council (Council) who is appointed to represent a specific private sector industry must be removed from the Council if he or she enters into employment outside of the industry or outside the private sector.

Requires the governor to select appointees to the Council to represent private sector industries from a list of nominations provided by the trade associations representing the industry instead of the largest trade association representing the industry.

Creates an effective date of July 1, 2018, for all sections of the bill except those that create new fees for licensing of architects and entities engaged in the practice of architecture.

Creates an effective date of October 1, 2018, for the new fees for licensing of architects and entities engaged in the practice of architecture.

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
