- On page 7, at the beginning of line 26 of the striking 1 2 amendment, strike all material through "used.))" on line 32, and 3 insert "((city)) legislative authority of any city located in that 4 county, with a population of sixty-five thousand or less, or a 5 population of one hundred thirty-five thousand or more, may ((submit 6 an authorizing proposition to the city voters at a special or 7 general election and, if the proposition is approved by a majority 8 of persons voting,)) impose the whole or remainder of the sales and 9 use tax rate in accordance with the terms of this chapter. The rate 10 of tax under this section may not exceed one-tenth of one percent of 11 the selling price in the case of a sales tax, or value of the 12 article used, in the case of a use tax. 13 (iii) If a county with a population of greater than one million 14 five hundred thousand has not imposed the full tax authorized under 15 (a) of this subsection within three years of October 9, 2015, the 16 legislative authority of any city with a population greater than 17 sixty-five thousand, but less than one hundred thirty-five thousand, 18 and with any portion of such population within that county, may 19 submit an authorizing proposition to the city voters at a special or 20 general election and, if the proposition is approved by a majority 21 of persons voting, impose the whole or remainder of the sales and 22 use tax rate in accordance with the terms of this chapter. The title 23 of each ballot measure must clearly state the purposes for which the 24 proposed sales and use tax will be used."
 - EFFECT: Requires a vote of the people to impose the 0.1 percent sales tax for affordable housing for cities between 65,000 and 135,000 people, and any part of such populations within a county over 1.5 million people.
