14 services waiver by approximately three-hundred and eighty clients by
15 the end of the 2017-19 biennium. Within the amount appropriated in
16 this subsection, the developmental disabilities administration shall
17 focus on extending services to eligible individuals with developmental
18 disabilities who are not otherwise receiving paid services from the
19 developmental disabilities administration."

12 administration pursuant to section 205(1)(aa) of this act."

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EFFECT: Funds a phase-in of 380 clients to the Individual & Family Services (IFS) waiver to increase access to respite care services within the DSHS Developmental Disabilities Administration (DDA) by the end of the 2017-19 biennium. DDA must focus on expanding IFS waiver access to clients who are currently not receiving paid DDA services. Includes funding in HCA that is sufficient for the estimated impact of Medicaid medical assistance for the new waiver clients.

FISCAL IMPACT:

Increases General Fund - State by \$1,640,000.

Increases General Fund - Federal by \$1,806,000.

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
