- 8 (ix) Civil penalties and administrative actions for regulatory
- 9 violations by a retailer holding a medical marijuana delivery
- 10 endorsement.
- 11 (d) By December 1, 2018, the board must report to the
- 12 legislature and the appropriate committees its findings and
- 13 recommendations regarding the implementation of a medical marijuana
- 14 home delivery system."

EFFECT: Requires the Liquor and Cannabis Board to study the legal and regulatory issues raised by the implementation of a home delivery system for medical marijuana products to qualifying medical marijuana patients and to report its findings and any recommendations to the Legislature by December 1, 2018.
