1 On page 58, after line 24 insert the following:

3 "(7)(a) Within amounts appropriated in this section, the state
4 liquor and cannabis board shall conduct a study regarding the
5 development and implementation of a system for the home delivery of
6 medical marijuana products to qualifying medical marijuana patients
7 by licensed medical marijuana retailers. The board shall examine
8 the legal and regulatory issues to be addressed in order to provide
9 safe home delivery and to ensure effective monitoring of the
10 delivery process to minimize the likelihood of illicit activity.

11 (b) The board shall consult with the department of health,
12 industry representatives, local government officials, law
13 enforcement officials, and any other person or entity deemed
14 necessary complete the study.

15 (c) In the course of the study, the board shall consider the
16 following:

17 (i) Eligibility requirements for marijuana retailers applying
18 for a medical marijuana delivery endorsement;

19 (ii) Verification procedures regarding age, identity, and
20 registration in the medical marijuana authorization database with
21 respect to the medical marijuana patient receiving delivery;

22 (iii) Qualifications for, and the training of, persons
23 delivering medical marijuana products on behalf of the medical
24 marijuana retailer;

25 (iv) Methods of ordering and payment;

26 (v) Maintaining the integrity of the marijuana traceability
27 system during the course of the delivery process;

1 (vi) Safe and secure transportation of marijuana products from
2 the retailer to the purchaser, including delivery vehicle
3 requirements;

4 (vii) Methods of ensuring that a retailer's delivery employees
5 and delivery system are in compliance with regulatory requirements;

6 (viii) Medical marijuana deliveries by retailers operating out
7 of Indian country; and

8 (ix) Civil penalties and administrative actions for regulatory
9 violations by a retailer holding a medical marijuana delivery
10 endorsement.

11 (d) By December 1, 2018, the board must report to the
12 legislature and the appropriate committees its findings and
13 recommendations regarding the implementation of a medical marijuana
14 home delivery system."

EFFECT: Requires the Liquor and Cannabis Board to study the legal and regulatory issues raised by the implementation of a home delivery system for medical marijuana products to qualifying medical marijuana patients and to report its findings and any recommendations to the Legislature by December 1, 2018.

FISCAL IMPACT: No net change to appropriated levels.
