1 Strike everything after the enacting clause and insert the
2 following:

3 "NEW SECTION. **Sec. 1.** A new section is added to chapter 43.70
4 RCW to read as follows:

5 (1) By July 1, 2020, the department shall establish, in
6 consultation with pharmacists and pharmacies, a searchable database
7 available on its web site of pharmacies that have one or more
8 pharmacists on staff with collaborative drug therapy agreements to
9 prescribe vaccines or self-administered hormonal contraceptives. The
10 database must include:

11 (a) The name and location of every pharmacy in the state with one
12 or more pharmacists on staff that through a collaborative drug
13 agreement prescribe:

14 (i) Vaccines; or

15 (ii) Self-administered hormonal contraceptives;

16 (b) A listing, by pharmacy, of the general categories and types
17 of vaccines and self-administered hormonal contraceptives, as
18 determined by the pharmacy quality assurance commission, that one or
19 more pharmacists on staff at each pharmacy in (a) of this subsection
20 are authorized to prescribe under a collaborative drug therapy
21 agreement; and

22 (c) A statement that the names and locations provided are
23 provided for information only and are subject to change.

24 (2) The searchable database must allow users to search by zip
25 code and include a map function displaying the closest locations to
26 the user based on zip code.

27 (3) The department shall update the database quarterly.

28 (4) If the department determines that a statewide association of
29 pharmacists or pharmacies provides a publicly available database
30 substantially similar to the requirement of this section, the
31 department is no longer required to establish or operate the database
32 required under subsection (1) of this section.

1 NEW SECTION. **Sec. 2.** A new section is added to chapter 18.64
2 RCW to read as follows:

3 Beginning April 1, 2020, any pharmacy in the state with one or
4 more pharmacists on staff that prescribe vaccines or self-
5 administered hormonal contraceptives through a collaborative drug
6 therapy agreement shall electronically provide the department with
7 the information required by section 1 of this act, as requested by
8 the department and in a format identified by the department."

9 Correct the title.

EFFECT: Allows the department of health (department) to forgo
establishing or operating the database if it determines that a
statewide association of pharmacists or pharmacies is providing a
substantially similar publicly available database. Changes the date
the database must be established to move it back one year, so that
the department is not required to establish the database until July
1, 2020, and pharmacies are not required to provide data to the
department regarding the database until April 1, 2020. Requires the
department to establish the database in consultation with pharmacists
and pharmacies.

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
