On page 42, after line 22 of the striking amendment, inserting the 1 2 following: 3 "NEW SECTION. Sec. 22. (1) The department of transportation 5 shall cease operations of the express toll lanes on Interstate 405 6 for ninety consecutive days, to commence no later than September 1, 7 2018. During the temporary shutdown of the express toll lanes, the 8 department shall allow all vehicles to travel in all lanes of 9 Interstate 405 between Lynnwood and Bellevue. The department shall 10 conduct adequate public outreach prior to the ninety-day change and 11 shall modify the facility's operation by changing the messaging on 12 the electronic signage to inform drivers the lanes are open to all, 13 similar to the current procedure when operations change for the 14 weekend or evening hours. (2) The department shall continue to collect corridor data in 15 16 the same way and aggregate the data solely for the ninety-day period 17 of the temporary shutdown of the express toll lanes. A report for 18 this ninety-day period summarizing the same performance measures as 19 the first twenty-four month period quarterly performance updates, 20 including applicable performance measures listed in RCW 21 47.56.880(4), is due to the transportation committees of the 22 legislature by January 7, 2019. 23 (3) In collaboration with the department of ecology, the

24 department must study the impacts on greenhouse gas emissions as a

25 result of the express toll lane closure.

1 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 23.** Section 22 of this act expires July 1, 2 2019.

- 4 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 24.** Section 22 of this act is necessary for
- 5 the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, or safety,
- 6 or support of the state government and its existing public
- 7 institutions, and takes effect immediately."

9 Renumber the remaining sections consecutively and correct any 10 internal references accordingly.

EFFECT: Requires the Department of Transportation (Department) to cease operations of the Interstate 405 express toll lanes for 90 days. Requires the Department to continue to collect corridor data during the shutdown and report performance measures to the Legislature by January 7, 2019. Requires the Department to study the impacts of the shutdown on greenhouse gas emissions.
