12 (3) Applicants for initial and renewal professional firefighters 13 and paramedics special license plates must show proof of eligibility 14 by providing a certificate of current membership from the Washington 15 state council of firefighters.

16 (4) Applicants for initial volunteer firefighters special 17 license plates must (a) have been a volunteer firefighter for at 18 least ten years or be a volunteer firefighter for one or more years 19 and (b) have documentation of service from the district of the 20 appropriate fire service. If the volunteer firefighter leaves 21 firefighting service before ten years of service have been 22 completed, the volunteer firefighter shall surrender the license 23 plates to the department on the registration renewal date. If the 24 volunteer firefighter stays in service for at least ten years and 25 then leaves, the license plate may be retained by the former 26 volunteer firefighter and as long as the license plate is retained 27 for use the person will continue to pay the future registration 28 renewals. A qualifying volunteer firefighter may have no more than 29 one set of license plates per vehicle, and a maximum of two sets per 30 applicant, for their personal vehicles. If the volunteer firefighter 31 is convicted of a violation of RCW 46.61.502 or a felony, the 32 license plates must be surrendered upon conviction.

18 The fish and wildlife enforcement reward account is created in the 19 custody of the state treasurer. Deposits to the account include: 20 Receipts from fish and shellfish overages as a result of a department 21 enforcement action; fees for hunter education deferral applications; 22 fees for master hunter applications and master hunter certification 23 renewals; during the 2017-2019 fiscal biennium, fees for national 24 rifle association license plates as provided in RCW 46.68.425; all 25 receipts from criminal wildlife penalty assessments under this 26 chapter; all receipts of court-ordered restitution or donations 27 associated with any fish, shellfish, or wildlife enforcement action; 28 and proceeds from forfeitures and evidence pursuant to RCW 77.15.070 29 and 77.15.100. The department may accept money or personal property 30 from persons under conditions requiring the property or money to be 31 used consistent with the intent of expenditures from the fish and 32 wildlife enforcement reward account. Expenditures from the account may 33 be used only for investigation and prosecution of fish and wildlife 34 offenses, to provide rewards to persons informing the department about

1 violations of this title and rules adopted under this title, to offset 2 department-approved costs incurred to administer the hunter education 3 deferral program and the master hunter permit program, <u>for the</u> 4 <u>enhanced support of firearm safety and education as part of the</u> 5 <u>hunter education training program under RCW 77.32.155 during the</u> 6 <u>2017-2019 fiscal biennium</u>, and for other valid enforcement uses as 7 determined by the commission. Only the director or the director's 8 designee may authorize expenditures from the account. The account is 9 subject to allotment procedures under chapter 43.88 RCW, but an 10 appropriation is not required for expenditures.

14 (1) "National rifle association license plates" means special 15 license plates issued under RCW 46.18.200 that display the National 16 Rifle Association logo.

<u>EFFECT</u>: During the 2017-2019 fiscal biennium: 1) Allows the Department of Licensing to issue special license plates that display the National Rifle Association (NRA) logo; 2) Sets the cost of the NRA special license plate at \$40 for an initial plate and \$30 for renewals, in addition to all other taxes and fees required upon application for vehicle registration; and 3) Requires proceeds from the NRA special license plate to be credited to the fish and wildlife enforcement reward account to be used for firearm safety and education.

FISCAL IMPACT: No net change to appropriated levels.
