- 14 effect of preventing a licensee from receiving an occupancy permit

EFFECT: (1) Increases from three months to nine months the grace period during which the board may not cause the forfeiture of a retail marijuana license held by a licensee following the effective date of the act; (2) Prohibits the board from requiring the forfeiture of a retail marijuana license if the reason for the licensees failure to open a fully operational business is the result of legal or regulatory actions by the city, town, or county that have the effect of preventing the licensee from opening the business.
