1 Strike everything after the enacting clause and insert the
2 following:

3 "NEW SECTION. **Sec. 1.** A new section is added to chapter 44.04
4 RCW to read as follows:

5 The secretary of the senate and the chief clerk of the house of
6 representatives may administer and conduct a legislative page
7 scholarship program to provide resources for Washington students who
8 participate in the page programs of the senate or house of
9 representatives. The scholarship program should provide assistance to
10 students, based on financial need, who qualify for a page program.
11 The program is called the Gina Grant Bull memorial legislative page
12 scholarship program.

13 NEW SECTION. **Sec. 2.** A new section is added to chapter 44.04
14 RCW to read as follows:

15 (1) The secretary of the senate and the chief clerk of the house
16 of representatives may solicit and accept gifts, grants, conveyances,
17 bequests, and devises of real or personal property, or both, in trust
18 or otherwise, and sell, lease, exchange, or expend these donations or
19 the proceeds, rents, profits, and income from the donations except as
20 limited by the donor's terms. Any legislative member or legislative
21 employee may solicit the same types of contributions for the
22 secretary of the senate and the chief clerk of the house of
23 representatives.

24 (2) Moneys received under this section may be used only for
25 establishing and operating the legislative page scholarship program
26 authorized in section 1 of this act.

27 (3) Moneys received under this section must be deposited in the
28 Gina Grant Bull memorial legislative page scholarship account
29 established in section 3 of this act.

1 (4) The secretary of the senate and the chief clerk of the house
2 of representatives must adopt joint rules to govern and protect the
3 receipt and expenditure of the proceeds.

4 NEW SECTION. **Sec. 3.** A new section is added to chapter 44.04
5 RCW to read as follows:

6 The Gina Grant Bull memorial legislative page scholarship account
7 is created in the custody of the state treasurer. All moneys received
8 under section 1 of this act must be deposited in the account.
9 Expenditures from the account may be made only for the purposes of
10 the legislative page scholarship program in section 1 of this act.
11 Only the secretary of the senate or the chief clerk of the house of
12 representatives or their designee may authorize expenditures from the
13 account. An appropriation is not required for expenditures, but the
14 account is subject to allotment procedures under chapter 43.88 RCW.

15 NEW SECTION. **Sec. 4.** A new section is added to chapter 42.52
16 RCW to read as follows:

17 This chapter does not prohibit the secretary of the senate, the
18 chief clerk of the house of representatives, or their designee from
19 soliciting and accepting contributions to the Gina Grant Bull
20 memorial legislative page scholarship account created in section 3 of
21 this act. Furthermore, this chapter does not prohibit any legislative
22 member or legislative employee from soliciting gifts for the Gina
23 Grant Bull memorial legislative page scholarship account.

24 **Sec. 5.** RCW 43.79A.040 and 2016 c 203 s 2, 2016 c 173 s 10, 2016
25 c 69 s 21, and 2016 c 39 s 7 are each reenacted and amended to read
26 as follows:

27 (1) Money in the treasurer's trust fund may be deposited,
28 invested, and reinvested by the state treasurer in accordance with
29 RCW 43.84.080 in the same manner and to the same extent as if the
30 money were in the state treasury, and may be commingled with moneys
31 in the state treasury for cash management and cash balance purposes.

32 (2) All income received from investment of the treasurer's trust
33 fund must be set aside in an account in the treasury trust fund to be
34 known as the investment income account.

35 (3) The investment income account may be utilized for the payment
36 of purchased banking services on behalf of treasurer's trust funds
37 including, but not limited to, depository, safekeeping, and

1 disbursement functions for the state treasurer or affected state
2 agencies. The investment income account is subject in all respects to
3 chapter 43.88 RCW, but no appropriation is required for payments to
4 financial institutions. Payments must occur prior to distribution of
5 earnings set forth in subsection (4) of this section.

6 (4)(a) Monthly, the state treasurer must distribute the earnings
7 credited to the investment income account to the state general fund
8 except under (b), (c), and (d) of this subsection.

9 (b) The following accounts and funds must receive their
10 proportionate share of earnings based upon each account's or fund's
11 average daily balance for the period: The 24/7 sobriety account, the
12 Washington promise scholarship account, the Gina Grant Bull memorial
13 legislative page scholarship account, the Washington advanced college
14 tuition payment program account, the Washington college savings
15 program account, the accessible communities account, the Washington
16 achieving a better life experience program account, the community and
17 technical college innovation account, the agricultural local fund,
18 the American Indian scholarship endowment fund, the foster care
19 scholarship endowment fund, the foster care endowed scholarship trust
20 fund, the contract harvesting revolving account, the Washington state
21 combined fund drive account, the commemorative works account, the
22 county enhanced 911 excise tax account, the toll collection account,
23 the developmental disabilities endowment trust fund, the energy
24 account, the fair fund, the family leave insurance account, the food
25 animal veterinarian conditional scholarship account, the fruit and
26 vegetable inspection account, the future teachers conditional
27 scholarship account, the game farm alternative account, the GET ready
28 for math and science scholarship account, the Washington global
29 health technologies and product development account, the grain
30 inspection revolving fund, the industrial insurance rainy day fund,
31 the juvenile accountability incentive account, the law enforcement
32 officers' and firefighters' plan 2 expense fund, the local tourism
33 promotion account, the multiagency permitting team account, the
34 pilotage account, the produce railcar pool account, the regional
35 transportation investment district account, the rural rehabilitation
36 account, the Washington sexual assault kit account, the stadium and
37 exhibition center account, the youth athletic facility account, the
38 self-insurance revolving fund, the children's trust fund, the
39 Washington horse racing commission Washington bred owners' bonus fund
40 and breeder awards account, the Washington horse racing commission

1 class C purse fund account, the individual development account
2 program account, the Washington horse racing commission operating
3 account, the life sciences discovery fund, the Washington state
4 heritage center account, the reduced cigarette ignition propensity
5 account, the center for childhood deafness and hearing loss account,
6 the school for the blind account, the Millersylvania park trust fund,
7 the public employees' and retirees' insurance reserve fund, and the
8 radiation perpetual maintenance fund.

9 (c) The following accounts and funds must receive eighty percent
10 of their proportionate share of earnings based upon each account's or
11 fund's average daily balance for the period: The advanced right-of-
12 way revolving fund, the advanced environmental mitigation revolving
13 account, the federal narcotics asset forfeitures account, the high
14 occupancy vehicle account, the local rail service assistance account,
15 and the miscellaneous transportation programs account.

16 (d) Any state agency that has independent authority over accounts
17 or funds not statutorily required to be held in the custody of the
18 state treasurer that deposits funds into a fund or account in the
19 custody of the state treasurer pursuant to an agreement with the
20 office of the state treasurer shall receive its proportionate share
21 of earnings based upon each account's or fund's average daily balance
22 for the period.

23 (5) In conformance with Article II, section 37 of the state
24 Constitution, no trust accounts or funds shall be allocated earnings
25 without the specific affirmative directive of this section."

26 Correct the title.

EFFECT: Renames the Legislative Page Scholarship Account the Gina
Grant Bull Memorial Legislative Page Scholarship Account.
