- 6 (a) To wrongfully obtain or exert unauthorized control over the 7 property or services of another or the value thereof, with intent to 8 deprive him or her of such property or services; or
- 9 (b) By color or aid of deception to obtain control over the 10 property or services of another or the value thereof, with intent to 11 deprive him or her of such property or services; or
- 12 (c) To appropriate lost or misdelivered property or services of 13 another, or the value thereof, with intent to deprive him or her of 14 such property or services; or
- 15 <u>(d) To conceal property of another intending that the concealment</u> 16 will deprive the other person of its use or benefit.
- 17 (2) In any prosecution for theft, it shall be a sufficient 18 defense that:
- 19 (a) The property or service was appropriated openly and avowedly 20 under a claim of title made in good faith, even though the claim be 21 untenable; or
- 22 (b) The property was merchandise pallets that were received by a 23 pallet recycler or repairer in the ordinary course of its business."
- 24 Correct the title.

EFFECT: Provides that in order to meet the definition of theft through concealment of property, the concealment must be with the intent to deprive, rather than "permanently" deprive, another of the property's use or benefit.
