- 15 receive a monthly retirement allowance of less than twenty-four
- 16 dollars and twenty-two cents times the number of years of service
- 17 creditable to the person whose service is the basis of such
- 18 retirement allowance.
- 19 (2) Where the retirement allowance payable was adjusted at the
- 20 time benefit payments to the beneficiary commenced, the minimum
- 21 allowance provided in this section shall be adjusted in a manner
- 22 consistent with that adjustment.
- 23 (3) Beginning July 1, 1996, the minimum benefit set forth in
- 24 subsection (1) of this section shall be adjusted annually by the
