EFFECT: Replaces the provisions of the bill with a 3 percent increase in the Public Employees' Retirement System and Teachers' Retirement System Plans 1 minimum benefits. On July 1, 2018, the basic minimum benefit increases from \$59.89 per year (\$24.22 plus subsequent adjustments) of service per month to \$61.69, and the alternative minimum benefit increases from \$1,900.15 dollars per month (\$1,500 plus adjustments) to \$1957.15 per month.
