20 difference of the state local effort assistance threshold and a school
21 district's maximum allowable enrichment levy divided by the school
22 district's student enrollment in the prior school year.

23 (e) "Prior school year" means the most recent school year
24 completed prior to the year in which the state local effort assistance
25 funding is to be distributed.

26 (f) "State local effort assistance threshold" means one thousand
27 five hundred dollars per student, adjusted for inflation beginning in
28 calendar year 2020.

29 (g) "Student enrollment" means the average annual resident full-
30 time equivalent student enrollment"

18 maximum dollar amount which may be levied by or for any school
19 district for enrichment levies under RCW 84.52.053 is equal to the
20 lesser of one dollar and fifty cents per thousand dollars of the
21 assessed value of property in the school district or the maximum per-
22 pupil limit.

23 (2) The definitions in this subsection apply to this section
24 unless the context clearly requires otherwise.

25 (a) "Inflation" means inflation as defined in RCW 84.55.005.

26 (b) "Maximum per-pupil limit" means two thousand five hundred
27 dollars, multiplied by the number of average annual resident full-time
28 equivalent students enrolled in the school district in the prior
29 school year. Beginning with property taxes levied for collection in
30 2020, the maximum per-pupil limit shall be increased by inflation.

31 (c) "Prior school year" means the most recent school year
32 completed prior to the year in which the levies are to be collected.

33 (3) For districts in a high/nonhigh relationship, the enrollments
34 of the nonhigh resident students attending the high school shall only

1 be counted by the nonhigh school districts for purposes of calculating
2 levy limitations under this section.

3 (4) Beginning with propositions for enrichment levies for
4 collection in calendar year 2020 and thereafter, a district must
5 receive approval of an enrichment levy expenditure plan under RCW
6 28A.505.240 before submission of the proposition to the voters.

7 ~~((4))~~(5) The superintendent of public instruction shall develop
8 rules and regulations and inform school districts of the pertinent
9 data necessary to carry out the provisions of this section.

10 ~~((5))~~(6) Beginning with taxes levied for collection in 2020,
11 enrichment levy revenues must be deposited in a separate subfund of
12 the school district's general fund pursuant to RCW 28A.320.330, and
13 are subject to the restrictions of RCW 28A.150.276 and the audit
14 requirements of RCW 43.09.2856.

15 ~~((6))~~(7) Funds collected from transportation vehicle enrichment
16 levies shall not be subject to the levy limitations in this section."

EFFECT: Removes several sections (103, 104, 105, 201, 202, 203,
204, 205, 207, 208, 303, 305, 307, 402, 406, 407, 408, 409, and
410) and changes in the underlying striking amendment, leaving
only the provisions below.

The amendment:

- Increases the special education excess cost multiplier from 0.9309 to 0.9609.
- Requires the Special Education State Oversight Committee to consider the high-cost needs of students enrolled in special education served by institutions.
- Delays the requirement to meet a 17:1 class size ratio for kindergarten through 3rd grade to receive funding at that ratio until September 1, 2019.
- Specifies a hold harmless payment for the 2018-19 and 2019-20 school years if the total of the state allocation, enrichment levies, and LEA for a district is less than what a district would have received based on levies collected in calendar year 2017.
- Updates statutes related to charter schools, tribal schools, the State School for the Blind, and the Washington State Center for Childhood Deafness and Hearing Loss to refer to regionalization factors.
- Clarifies a reference to the Implicit Price Deflator used for inflation.
- Adds language describing the relationship between high and non-high districts regarding local enrichment levies and Local Effort Assistance.

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
