1 Strike everything after the enacting clause and insert the
2 following:

3 "Sec. 1. RCW 9A.44.115 and 2003 c 213 s 1 are each amended to
4 read as follows:

5 (1) As used in this section:

6 (a) "Intimate areas" means any portion of a person's body or
7 undergarments that is covered by clothing and intended to be
8 protected from public view;

9 (b) "Photographs" or "films" means the making of a photograph,
10 motion picture film, videotape, digital image, or any other recording
11 or transmission of the image of a person;

12 (c) "Place where he or she would have a reasonable expectation of
13 privacy" means:

14 (i) A place where a reasonable person would believe that he or
15 she could disrobe in privacy, without being concerned that his or her
16 undressing was being photographed or filmed by another; or

17 (ii) A place where one may reasonably expect to be safe from
18 casual or hostile intrusion or surveillance;

19 (d) "Surveillance" means secret observation of the activities of
20 another person for the purpose of spying upon and invading the
21 privacy of the person;

22 (e) "Views" means the intentional looking upon of another person
23 for more than a brief period of time, in other than a casual or
24 cursory manner, with the unaided eye or with a device designed or
25 intended to improve visual acuity.

26 (2)(a) A person commits the crime of voyeurism in the first
27 degree if, for the purpose of arousing or gratifying the sexual
28 desire of any person, he or she knowingly views, photographs, or
29 films:

30 ((+a)) (i) Another person without that person's knowledge and
31 consent while the person being viewed, photographed, or filmed is in

1 a place where he or she would have a reasonable expectation of
2 privacy; or

3 ~~((b))~~ (ii) The intimate areas of another person without that
4 person's knowledge and consent and under circumstances where the
5 person has a reasonable expectation of privacy, whether in a public
6 or private place.

7 ~~((3))~~ (b) Voyeurism in the first degree is a class C felony.

8 (3)(a) A person commits the crime of voyeurism in the second
9 degree if he or she intentionally photographs or films another person
10 for the purpose of photographing or filming the intimate areas of
11 that person with the intent to distribute or disseminate the
12 photograph or film, without that person's knowledge and consent, and
13 under circumstances where the person has a reasonable expectation of
14 privacy, whether in a public or private place.

15 (b) Voyeurism in the second degree is a gross misdemeanor.

16 (c) Voyeurism in the second degree is not a sex offense for the
17 purposes of sentencing or sex offender registration requirements
18 under this chapter.

19 (4) This section does not apply to viewing, photographing, or
20 filming by personnel of the department of corrections or of a local
21 jail or correctional facility for security purposes or during
22 investigation of alleged misconduct by a person in the custody of the
23 department of corrections or the local jail or correctional facility.

24 (5) If a person is convicted of a violation of this section, the
25 court may order the destruction of any photograph, motion picture
26 film, digital image, videotape, or any other recording of an image
27 that was made by the person in violation of this section.

28 **Sec. 2.** RCW 13.40.070 and 2013 c 179 s 3 are each amended to
29 read as follows:

30 (1) Complaints referred to the juvenile court alleging the
31 commission of an offense shall be referred directly to the
32 prosecutor. The prosecutor, upon receipt of a complaint, shall screen
33 the complaint to determine whether:

34 (a) The alleged facts bring the case within the jurisdiction of
35 the court; and

36 (b) On a basis of available evidence there is probable cause to
37 believe that the juvenile did commit the offense.

38 (2) If the identical alleged acts constitute an offense under
39 both the law of this state and an ordinance of any city or county of

1 this state, state law shall govern the prosecutor's screening and
2 charging decision for both filed and diverted cases.

3 (3) If the requirements of subsections (1)(a) and (b) of this
4 section are met, the prosecutor shall either file an information in
5 juvenile court or divert the case, as set forth in subsections (5),
6 (6), and (8) of this section. If the prosecutor finds that the
7 requirements of subsection (1)(a) and (b) of this section are not
8 met, the prosecutor shall maintain a record, for one year, of such
9 decision and the reasons therefor. In lieu of filing an information
10 or diverting an offense a prosecutor may file a motion to modify
11 community supervision where such offense constitutes a violation of
12 community supervision.

13 (4) An information shall be a plain, concise, and definite
14 written statement of the essential facts constituting the offense
15 charged. It shall be signed by the prosecuting attorney and conform
16 to chapter 10.37 RCW.

17 (5) Except as provided in RCW 13.40.213 and subsection (7) of
18 this section, where a case is legally sufficient, the prosecutor
19 shall file an information with the juvenile court if:

20 (a) An alleged offender is accused of a class A felony, a class B
21 felony, an attempt to commit a class B felony, a class C felony
22 listed in RCW 9.94A.411(2) as a crime against persons or listed in
23 RCW 9A.46.060 as a crime of harassment, or a class C felony that is a
24 violation of RCW 9.41.080 or 9.41.040(2)(a)(~~(iii)~~) (iv); or

25 (b) An alleged offender is accused of a felony and has a criminal
26 history of any felony, or at least two gross misdemeanors, or at
27 least two misdemeanors; or

28 (c) An alleged offender has previously been committed to the
29 department; or

30 (d) An alleged offender has been referred by a diversion unit for
31 prosecution or desires prosecution instead of diversion; or

32 (e) An alleged offender has three or more diversion agreements on
33 the alleged offender's criminal history; or

34 (f) A special allegation has been filed that the offender or an
35 accomplice was armed with a firearm when the offense was committed.

36 (6) Where a case is legally sufficient the prosecutor shall
37 divert the case if the alleged offense is a misdemeanor or gross
38 misdemeanor or violation and the alleged offense is the offender's
39 first offense or violation. If the alleged offender is charged with a

1 related offense that must or may be filed under subsections (5) and
2 (8) of this section, a case under this subsection may also be filed.

3 (7) Where a case is legally sufficient to charge an alleged
4 offender with:

5 (a) Either prostitution or prostitution loitering and the alleged
6 offense is the offender's first prostitution or prostitution
7 loitering offense, the prosecutor shall divert the case; or

8 (b) Voyeurism in the second degree, the offender is under
9 seventeen years of age, and the alleged offense is the offender's
10 first voyeurism in the second degree offense, the prosecutor shall
11 divert the case, unless the offender has received two diversions for
12 any offense in the previous two years.

13 (8) Where a case is legally sufficient and falls into neither
14 subsection (5) nor (6) of this section, it may be filed or diverted.
15 In deciding whether to file or divert an offense under this section
16 the prosecutor shall be guided only by the length, seriousness, and
17 recency of the alleged offender's criminal history and the
18 circumstances surrounding the commission of the alleged offense.

19 (9) Whenever a juvenile is placed in custody or, where not placed
20 in custody, referred to a diversion interview, the parent or legal
21 guardian of the juvenile shall be notified as soon as possible
22 concerning the allegation made against the juvenile and the current
23 status of the juvenile. Where a case involves victims of crimes
24 against persons or victims whose property has not been recovered at
25 the time a juvenile is referred to a diversion unit, the victim shall
26 be notified of the referral and informed how to contact the unit.

27 (10) The responsibilities of the prosecutor under subsections (1)
28 through (9) of this section may be performed by a juvenile court
29 probation counselor for any complaint referred to the court alleging
30 the commission of an offense which would not be a felony if committed
31 by an adult, if the prosecutor has given sufficient written notice to
32 the juvenile court that the prosecutor will not review such
33 complaints.

34 (11) The prosecutor, juvenile court probation counselor, or
35 diversion unit may, in exercising their authority under this section
36 or RCW 13.40.080, refer juveniles to mediation or victim offender
37 reconciliation programs. Such mediation or victim offender
38 reconciliation programs shall be voluntary for victims.
