- "NEW SECTION. Sec. 7. The state of Washington fully occupies 4 5 and preempts the entire field of employment laws related to criminal records and other matters covered within this chapter within the boundaries of the state. Cities, towns, and counties or other 7 municipalities may enact only those laws and ordinances relating to 8 9 employment laws related to criminal records and other matters covered 10 within this chapter that are specifically authorized by state law and are consistent with this chapter. Local laws and ordinances in 11 12 existence on the effective date of this section that are inconsistent 13 with this chapter are preempted and repealed, regardless of the 14 nature of the code, charter, or home rule status of such a city, 15 town, county, or municipality."
- Renumber the remaining sections consecutively and correct any internal references accordingly.
- On page 4, line 16 of the amendment, after "6," insert "7,"
- On page 4, line 16 of the amendment, strike "8" and insert "9"

EFFECT: Removes the provisions: (1) That the act may not be construed to interfere with local government current and future laws that provide additional protections to individuals with criminal records; and (2) that local government laws that provide lesser protections conflict with this chapter and may not be enforced. Preempts local governments from enacting laws and ordinances relating to employment laws related to criminal records, except as authorized by state laws.
