1       On page 24, line 35, after "(b)" insert "The department must  
2 convene a monthly stakeholder meeting or information session where  
3 input and comments are requested from stakeholders regarding specific  
4 language used to display and present the information described in (a)  
5 and (c) of this subsection. Language related to license  
6 determinations must be reviewed for whether it is helpful to the  
7 consumer and whether the language is too inflammatory. The single  
8 source of information must be reviewed annually by the oversight  
9 board for children, youth, and families, and any language that chills  
10 consumer use of the single source or is unfairly inflammatory shall  
11 be removed. The department shall issue a report detailing the  
12 usefulness of the web resource and explaining instances where  
13 inflammatory language was used and then replaced on the web resource.

15       On page 25, at the beginning of line 3, strike "(c)" and insert  
16 "~~((e))~~ (d)"

17       On page 25, at the beginning of line 6, strike "(d)" and insert  
18 "~~((d))~~ (e)"

19       On page 25, at the beginning of line 9, strike "(e)" and insert  
20 "~~((e))~~ (f)"

EFFECT: Mandates a review of the Department web resource for efficacy as a consumer tool.

Requires review of language used on web resource.

Requires the Department to do an annual review of the web resource and report findings to the legislature. The report must include changes made to inflammatory language and recommendations from monthly stakeholder information sessions.

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
