- (1)The state of Washington fully occupies and 4 preempts the entire field of safe injection site regulation within 5 the boundaries of the state, including the registration, licensing, purchase, sale, acquisition, transfer, 7 authorization, or any other element relating to safe injection 8 sites. Cities, towns, and counties or other municipalities may only 9 enact laws and ordinances relating to safe injection sites that are 10 specifically authorized by state law and are consistent with this 11 chapter. Such local ordinances have the same penalty as provided for 12 by state law. Local laws and ordinances that are inconsistent with, 13 more restrictive than, or exceed the requirements of state law may 14 not be enacted and are preempted and repealed, regardless of the

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EFFECT:

- Permits Washington State to preempt the entire field of safe injection site regulation in the state.
- Local governments may only enact laws and ordinances relating to safe injection sites that are specifically authorized by state law.
- Any local government expenditures relating to safe injection sites void any claim made by it against the state General Fund.
- All funding claims by the local government will be denied until the state, health district, or county is able to certify that there are no safe injection sites operating within its jurisdiction.
- Adds a referendum clause.

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
